ChessPalace provides classes from the beginner to advance level. In addition to improving chess skills, studies and research have shown how chess has also positively affected academics, problem-solving skills, patience, diligence and attitude. Take advantage:

Every second and fourth Friday of each month, there is an Action Quad tournament at 7pm. This is a USCF-rated event so a yearly membership is due to the USCF (approx. \$16-\$27). Sign up at ChessPalace or USCF website. It's three rounds, G/30 time control. Current ChessPalace students are eligible to play in the tournament for free. This special offer to students allows students to improve in tournament play to gain experience and knowledge about the tournament environment and rules. Advanced class students are required to play at least once a month.

In addition, Super Class is conducted once or twice a month on a Sunday to bring all ChessPalace junior students together. This session will include, practice games, short lectures, tactics training, camaraderie with other students. A volunteer or ChessPalace coach will be available to assist students with questions and clarifications. Check events calendar for dates.
